Liver Transplant Program is **Best in Texas!**

The Liver Transplant Program at Methodist Specialty and Transplant Hospital* has received the best one-year and three-year transplant patient survival outcomes among all liver transplant centers in Texas. From January 2005 to June 2007, the program received a **92** percent one-year survival rate among patients receiving their first liver transplant. This rating is also above the national average for all liver transplant centers nationwide.
